

## How to use the Watermark feature in the KX Driver

### Process outline

- Upload high quality JPG or PNG file to your computer
- Configure Watermark settings
- Print the file

### Upload file to your computer

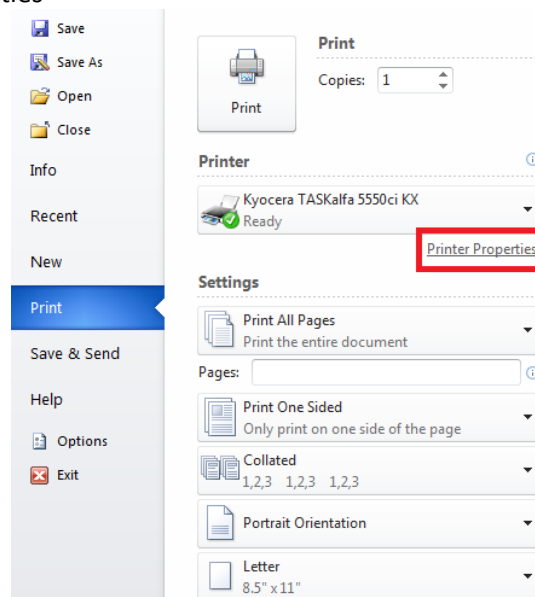
From the sample files, save the following PNG file to your computer **PNG HQ Flowers.png**

*Note: Always use a high quality PNG or JPG file format; this will ensure the highest quality output for use as company letterheads or as printable forms. Store the file in a folder where it is easily accessible.*

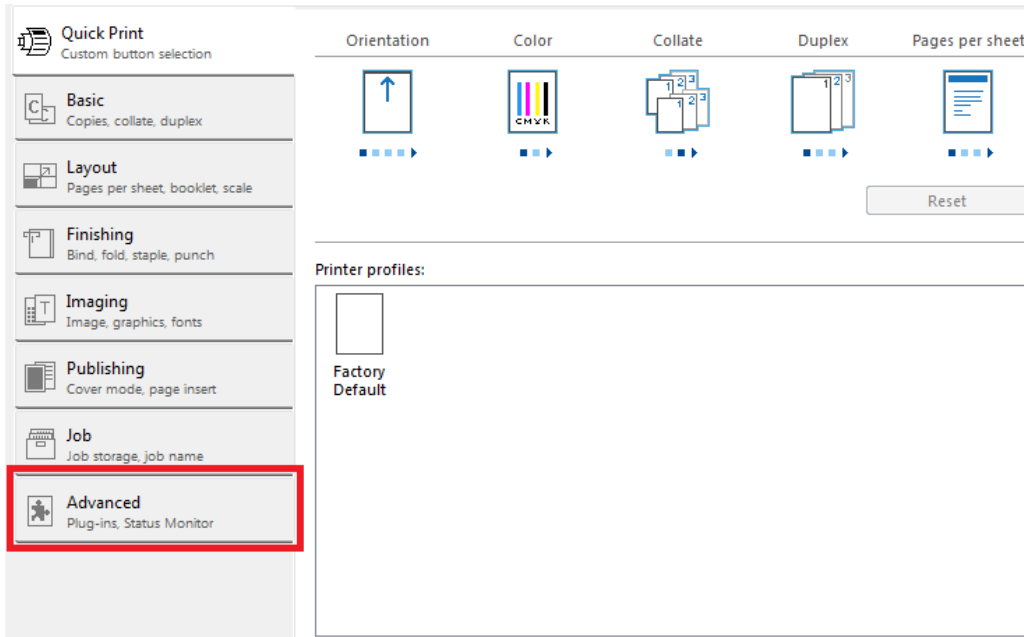
### Configuring the Watermark Settings before printing

*Note: Please make sure you are using the newest KX Driver to match the examples posted in this document. **KX Driver Version 6.1.1413 or later.***

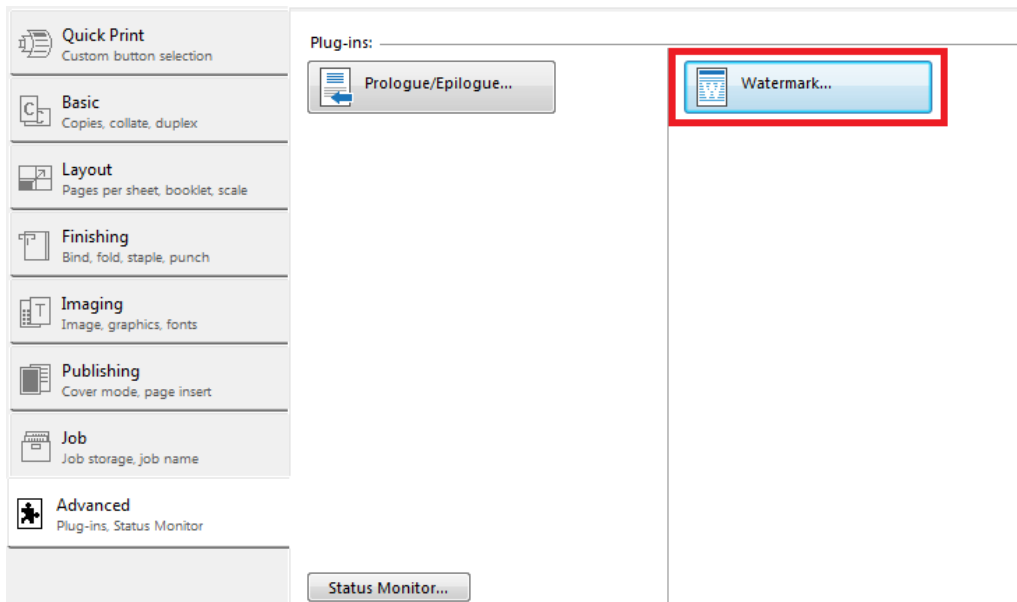
1. Open the sample file **Flowers Dear Customer.docx**  
*This file has the top margin formatted to fit under the sample letterhead PNG image file provided.*
2. Click Print
3. Select Printer Properties



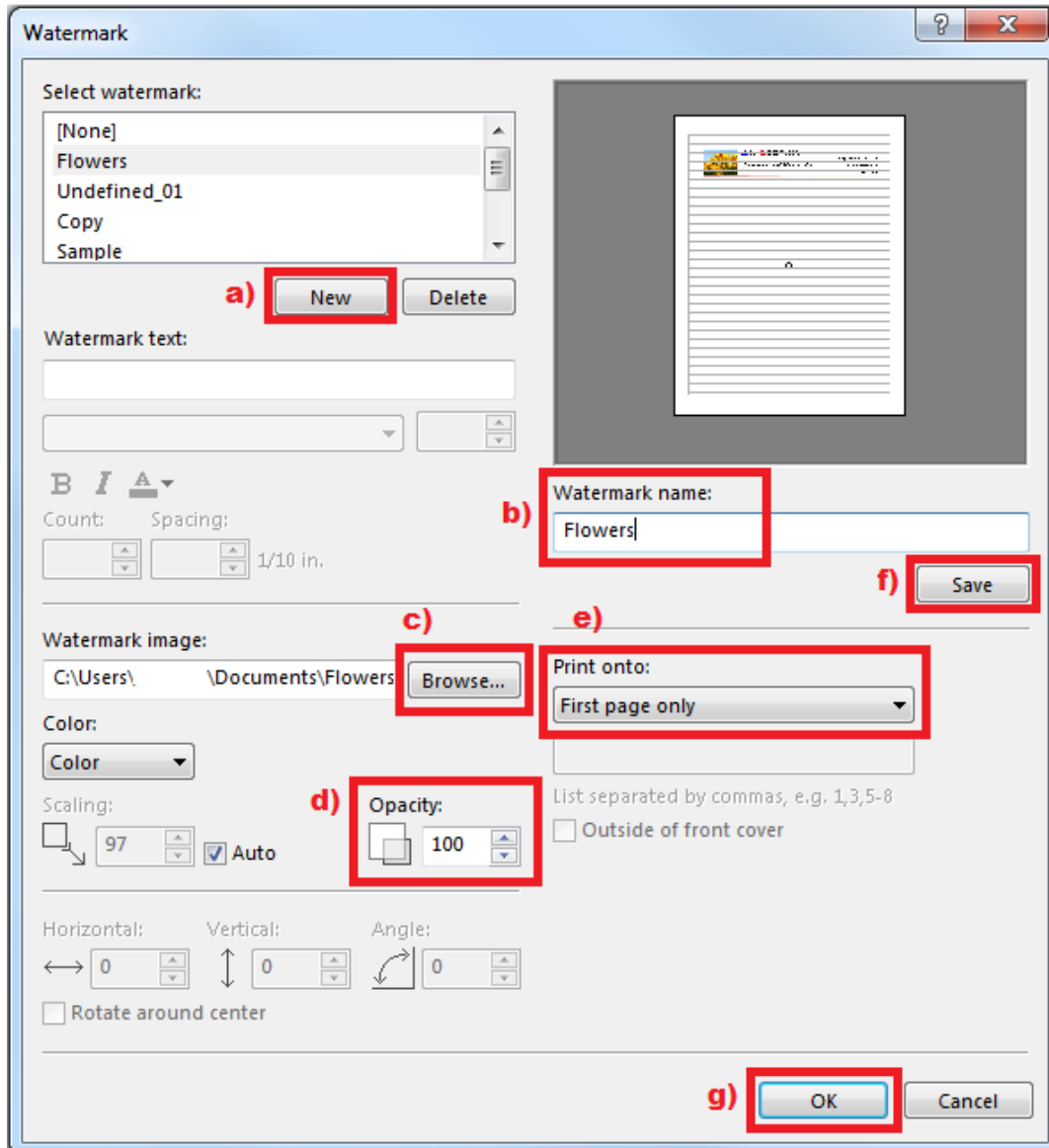
4. Select the Advanced tab



5. Select Watermark feature



6. Configure Watermark settings as follows:
  - a. Click New
  - b. Enter a name for the file (this example uses "Flowers")
  - c. Click Browse and navigate to where the image file is stored on your computer
  - d. Increase the Opacity to 100%
  - e. Adjust "Print onto" feature for desired purpose (this example uses First page only)
  - f. Click Save (as this is saved, this watermark can be recalled at any time in the future)
  - g. Click OK



7. Press OK on the next screen
8. Click the Print button from the main print window

The document will print with the image file acting as your letterhead.
